Changes to the Government Decree N164 28th January 2020 On the Approval of Measures to Prevent the Possible Spread of the Novel Coronavirus in Georgia and the Emergency Response Plan for the Cases of Novel Coronavirus Disease

1. According to Article 63 of the General Administrative Code of Georgia, Amendments to Paragraph # 164 of the Government of Georgia of January 28, 2020 on the Approval of Measures to Prevent the Possible Spread of the Novel Coronavirus in Georgia and the Emergency Response Plan for the Cases of Novel Coronavirus Disease shall be made to Article 5 of the Annex:

a) The first paragraph should be formulated as follows:

1. Without prejudice to the restrictions established by Article 4(4)(f) and Article 4(7)(b) and (b¹) of this Plan, aliens or stateless persons, who were staying legally in the territory of Georgia on 14 March 2020 and could not leave the country before the expiry of the period of legal stay in Georgia, shall have the right to stay in the territory of Georgia until 1 July 2021, provided that their stay in the territory of Georgia was caused by the following circumstances:

- a) the state of citizenship of the person was in a high-risk zone during the respective period;
- b) a restriction on the crossing of the border has been imposed by the respective state;
- c) the person was in hospital, quarantine or self-isolation because of his/her health condition;
- d) the person could not leave the country within the specified time due to cancelled flights.

b) Paragraph 3 should be removed

2. The decree is in force as of 1 January 2021
